Once again, the Hooversville Volunteer Fire Department is asking the residents and businesses of our fire protection area for their support. Everyone in our protection area can take pride in our local fire department for the standards of excellence maintained by our volunteers, along with maintenance, updating, and the replacement of valuable lifesaving and fire fighting equipment.

Annually, the fire department spends \$12,000 for Vehicle and Liability Insurance, and \$20,000 for vehicle maintenance, and equipment up-keep and/or replacement. Costs have increased to properly equip and protect each of our volunteer firefighters with PPE when they respond on emergency calls, with the average cost being \$12,000.00 per active firefighter.

Each year we continue to apply for funding through the State and Federal Fire Grant Programs to update and purchase new equipment, as well as using the Annual State Fire Grant Program for
